Advocacy Service for Children who are looked after (in care)

The Children`s Advocate ensures that the views of disabled children are considered.

Advocacy for School Pupils who are Disabled in a School Setting

Providing one to one advocacy for disabled pupils in a school setting, as well as providing training to school staff and pupils to improve inclusion for all disabled children and young people.

Advocacy for Carers

Do you care for a relative or friend? Are you confused over what is available to you and how to get it? Do you feel that no one is listening to you? If this is the case then maybe the Carer`s Advocate can help by representing your views or guiding you through the maze of services.

Payroll Service

The Direct Payments Payroll Service, can be provided for those clients wishing to have their carers pay, income tax and national insurance dealt with for a quarterly charge.

Parent Carers Support

Promoting parents as experts, representing views and providing pathways to services, information and resources.

Shoppmobility Services

Scooters, wheelchairs and powerchairs can be hired to assist with independent shopping and leisure within the Birkenhead and Liscard town centres. Birkenhead Shoppmobility is now open on Saturdays. We also sell a range of small disability aids at a competitive price.
